
## ORDER DATED 12<sup>th</sup> MARCH, 2014

Mr. Atul Jha, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the B.L. Mandal University and L.N. Mithila University files a Status Report, stating that the Universities have filed replies in all the 395 cases and 262 cases respectively. Let the same be kept on record.

Mr. Abhinav Mukerji, the learned counsel appearing for the State of Bihar states that a consolidated reply which has been filed be treated to be the reply in all such cases where replies could not be filed by the State either owing to non-availability of the claim petition or otherwise.

It is made clear that in such cases, the factual dispute, if any, would be considered from the replies filed by the Universities. Liberty, however, is granted to the State to bring to the Commissioner's notice any factual inaccuracy so as to enable the Commission to consider the same. Rejoinders to the replies filed by the State of Bihar, if any, may be filed by 31.3.2014.
