
As the commission is of the opinion that the grievances of some of the teaching and non teaching staff are required to be considered individually, the learned counsels appearing on behalf of the State of Bihar and the State of Jharkhand, are requested to bring the said cases to the notice of the commission at an appropriate stage of the proceeding of the Commission.

It was furthermore noticed that the grievances of the some of the teaching staff are that although the competent authority has passed orders directing their regularization, the Education Departments of the concerned States have not passed any order thereupon, simply on the ground that the matters are pending consideration before this Commission.

The learned counsels for the State and for the concerned universities are hereby requested to bring to the Commission's notice such cases so that they can be taken up for hearing on a priority basis.
